Attention Contractors, Landlords, Property Managers & Others:

Effective April 22, 2010 the Environmental Protection Agency and the State of North Carolina requires companies and their personnel performing renovation, repair and painting projects **that disturb lead-based paint** in homes, apartments, schools, child care facilities, etc. **built before 1978**, to be trained on the EPA Renovation, Repair and Painting Rule (RR&P) to follow specific work practices — to prevent lead hazard contamination — and to be RR&P certified.

The training will be provided by an EPA/NC-accredited training provider. Completion of this one day, 8 hour training is required to apply for a Renovator Firm Certification, a license issued by the Health Hazards Control Unit, a division of the NC Department of Health & Human Services.
